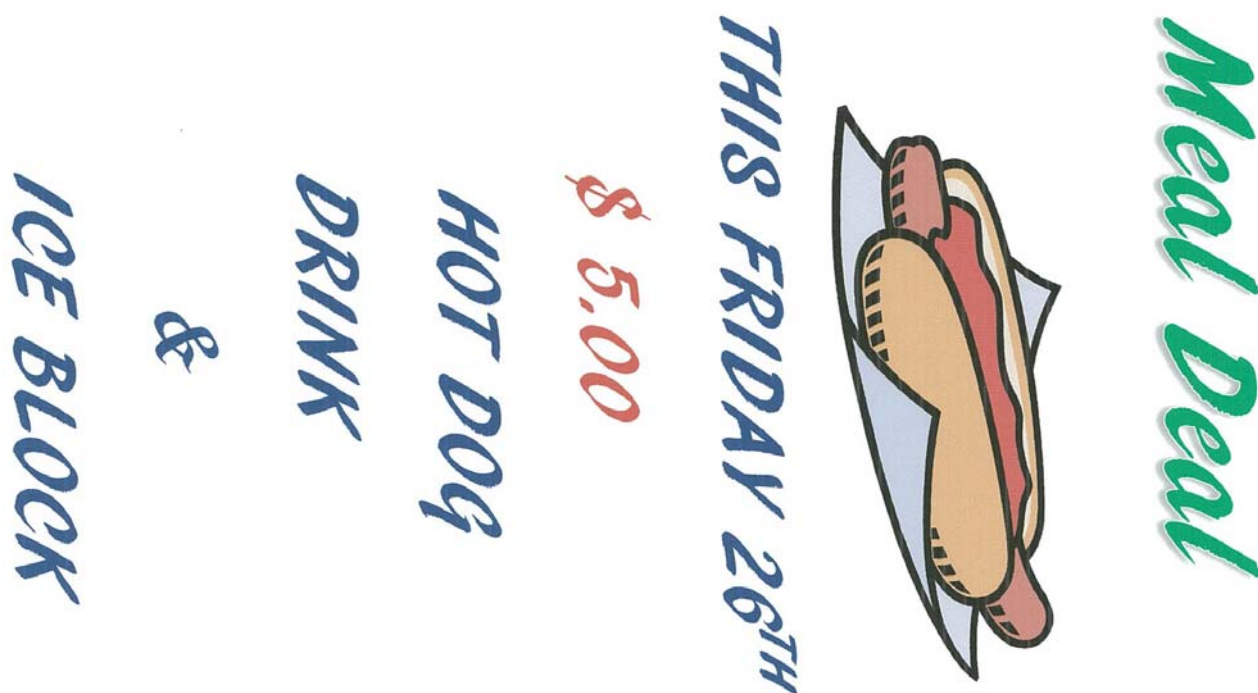
### Meal Deal
